Cubs - £90 : Visiting 3 days, 2 nights



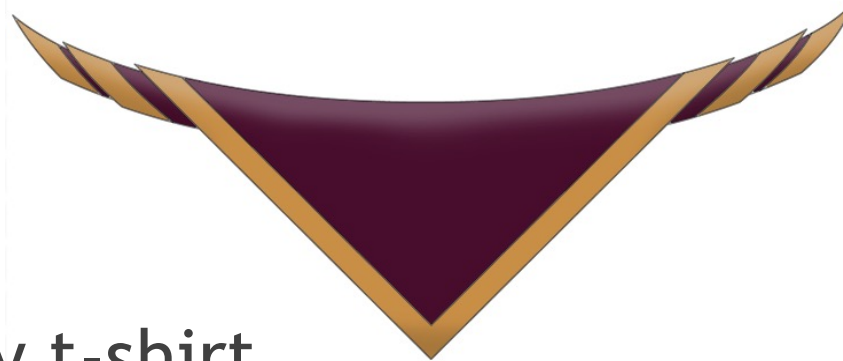
Scouts - £300 : Visiting 7 days, 6 nights

Payment plan (all dates are when monies are to be paid to District by groups)

- ▶ **30/11/23** - A non-refundable deposit of £30 per child would need to be paid by each group to District
- ▶ **28/02/24** - A second payment of £10 / £20 / £90 would be needed by paid each Beaver / Cub / Scout & Explorer respectively
- ▶ **30/04/24** - A third payment of £10 / £20 / £90 would be needed by paid each beaver / cub / scout respectively
- ▶ **30/06/24** - A final payment of £10 / £20 / £90 would be needed by each paid beaver / cub / scout respectively
